

BoBo shares that his wife is not one to talk about herself or her accomplishments, but in addition to her surgical specialization in breast and body procedures, she was the first female plastic surgeon in Arizona using Vectra XT, the most advanced 3D imaging system for breast and body procedures; miraDry, a safe, clinically proven, FDA-approved technology for permanent reduction in underarm sweat, odor and hair; and, for reconstructive surgery, was the first doctor in Arizona to use the AeroForm Tissue Expander, a new needle-free patient-controlled tissue expansion device for women who have had mastectomies. She is also the first female plastic surgeon in Arizona, and among the first in the country, to offer the BodyTite and FaceTite minimally invasive procedures, using patented radiofrequency assisted liposuction (RFAL<sup>™</sup>) technology for effective body contouring and significant skin contraction.

In addition to growing their respective careers, the couple also expanded their family, welcoming twin boys, Aiden and Ryder, in 2014.
